Around 3,500 people live in the village of Muotathal, surrounded by thick forests and imposing alpine peaks. Village life is lively, with several associations preserving local traditions such as yodeling and Swiss wrestling.

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STOOS



VILLAGE LIFE
A car-free village and skiing area within the Morschach commune, Stoos Village lies 1305m (4,300ft) above sea level on a high plateau. There are 150 residents, with 16 children currently attending the village school. In tourist season, up to 2200 visitors flock to stay in the village.

ACCOMMODATION & RESTAURANTS
Cozy comfort in the Stoos Hütte, pampering in the Stoos Hotel, Alpine chic in the Caschu Alp or a home-from-home in group accommodation or self-catering. Delicious food with a view – from regional specialities to modern cuisine or generous buffets.

FASCINATING FACTS
Regenerative energy: modern heat pumps use the excess heat generated in the Stoos funicular's machine room to keep the mountain station, the Stoos Shop, and the 100 bedrooms of Stoos Lodge warm and toasty.

HIGHLIGHTS SUMMER 2025



BÖDMEREN FOREST
At the very foot of the Muotatal Valley, the primeval forests of the Alps survive in the 550ha (1,360 acre) Bödmeren forest. Some parts of the forest have hardly felt the finger of mankind and remain just as they were in ancient times.

RIDESHARE BENCHES ON THE PRAGELPASS
In December 2017, the world's steepest funicular opened in the middle of a mountain village: Stoos. The funicular chugs up gradients of up to 110% = 47.7°. The innovative technology is unique in the world. Kids travel free of charge in summer with a 'Junior' or 'Kinder' family card.

WORLD'S STEEPEST FUNICULAR
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HERITAGE & TRADITION IN ILLGAU
Above us, the expanse of sky; below us, the endless void of the Hölloch; all around us, the bare karst: the rocky Silberen landscape is something special to see, boasting Switzerland's biggest karst formations. The trailhead is at the Pragel Pass, and the second part of the hike features stunning views into the Klöntal Valley.

THE SILBEREN KARST
Above us, the expanse of sky; below us, the endless void of the Hölloch; all around us, the bare karst: the rocky Silberen landscape is something special to see, boasting Switzerland's biggest karst formations. HÖLLOCH CAVES & VISITOR CENTER
With 210 kilometers (130 miles) explored to date, the Hölloch isn't just the biggest cave system in Switzerland, nor in Europe: it's one of the biggest in the world. A tour of the visitor center is the ideal way to comprehend the uniqueness of this natural wonder.


ACTIVITIES IN THE REGION



ILLGAU
Named after the local beetle, the Chäferliweg challenges you to find members of the beetle family – and discover something round every corner: play areas, barbecue spots... and more. Follow circular trails through sunny Illgau to the Fallenflue viewpoint, or towards Oberberg and Chaltenbrunnen.

MORSCHACH
Hunting beetles in the Chäferliweg in Illgau or spotting the wooden balls that mark the Fronalpweg trail on the Stoos – with educational themed trails, fun activities where the kids will love to stop and play, and hiking routes suited to strollers – every walk becomes an adventure.

INDOOR SPORT AND LEISURE PARK
Head to the Swiss Holiday Park for a host of fun activities from virtual reality to bowling, from billiards to table tennis or the movies, and all kinds of adventures in the 1,300m² (14,000 sq ft) Superdome. Another don't-miss is the FunPark at the Stoos Lodge.



STOOS
Take an intrepid hike through the Hölloch cave system and discover the world from the other side! Enjoy a climbing experience at erlebniswelt muotathal GmbH, or get an adrenalin charge on a wild water adventure such as kayaking or canyoning down the Muota River.


MUOTATHAL

VILLAGE LIFE
The village, with its 820 locals, is often referred to as a "sun terrace". The farmhouses dotted across the plateau and up to 1,300m (4,300ft) above sea level are home to working farms summer and winter.

On a sunny plateau above Brunnen, overlooking Lake Lucerne, Morschach enjoys a view of the historic Rütli meadow, the mountains of Canton Uri and down the wide valley of Schwyz. The village has around 1,200 residents.

ACCOMMODATION & RESTAURANTS
The tourist village offers self-catering accommodation, family-friendly campsites, and hotels. Tasty ice-cream, barbecue spots, and restaurants crossing the globe from Italy to Thailand – or authentic Schwyz cuisine: Morschach has it all.

FASCINATING FACTS
The hiking trail Weg der Schweiz, the Swiss Path, passes through the center of Morschach. The trail is a historic route through Switzerland's ancient landscapes, bringing together nature, tradition and history. Morschach is more than just a place to pass through on the trail: it is well worth stopping to explore.

THE RUGGED WEATHER REGION
The Fascination of Weather: «Beauty and Power of Nature»
The Stoos-Muotatal region has a strong connection to weather due to its extreme local phenomena – from foehn storms over Lake Uri, to record-low temperatures on Glättalp, rainy days in the Bödmeren primeval forest, or hours of sunshine on Stoos and the sun terrace of Illgau. Despite being only a few kilometers apart, the region hosts a wide range of contrasting weather extremes.

WETTERSCHMÖCKER
The home-grown "Wetterschmöcker", sometimes known as the "Muotathaler Wetterfrosche", is a group of hobby meteorologists from the inner Schwyz region. Their own observations of nature are certainly an ingredient of their weather forecasts, but the exact recipe is a well-guarded secret. Learn more during an entertaining talk from one of the group.
